A Tasty Brat Variation

Whatever the occasion may be, family reunion, baseball game, graduation party, or just simply for the heck of it, grilling brats is a staple of Wisconsin grilling. The funny thing about brats is that they're simple to make but everyone it seems to think

they have the best recipe or way of grilling them up.

I'm not here to debate who makes the best brats or the best ways for grilling them, but I do want to share a tasty, admittedly unhealthy variation that involves bacon and kraut!

What you do is take a fresh brat, make a slit in it the long way about half way through the brat. Next, you stuff the slit with kraut. After that, wrap

fresh bacon around the brat securing the kraut. From there you simply grill this masterpiece on the grill until it's cooked all the way through.

Some of you may be appalled by this concoction, but I assure you that it is very tasty.
